

Abyarns: 50 years of Blowing Bubbles History & Folklore of the South Australian Western Zone Abalone Industry

The South Australian Western Zone Abalone fishery has been operating on the Eyre Peninsula coastline since the early 1960's with the Industry Association being formed in November 1969. On the anniversary of 50 remarkable years, the Abalone Industry Association of South Australia (AIASA), saw it as an opportune time to capture, record and preserve the history of such a unique




