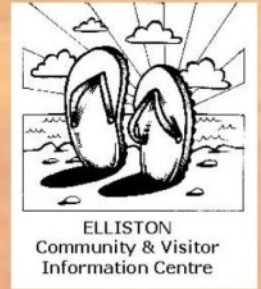

Q FEVER VACCINATIONS

Wudinna Medical Practice is seeking people interested in receiving a Q-Fever Vaccination in 2020.

It is a once off vaccination to protect you from Q-fever, an illness passed on from stock and wildlife.

The Q-Fever immunisation consists of two stages, a blood and skin test and the vaccination if suitable. There must be a week gap between the two..

No Medicare rebate is applicable to this vaccination process and we do require minimum numbers to hold the clinic. Dates and cost will be determined once numbers are confirmed, but we are looking at late August to October.

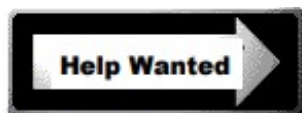
