### ANZAC DAY



We were blessed with no rain and a cracking sunrise for the Anzac Day dawn service held in town at our Anzac monument.

Approximately 70 people gathered that morning to pay our respects to those who sacrificed so much for what we have today.

The service was well delivered by Kim & Caroline Gillet and Brevit Sergeant Ashley Traeger attended to the flag protocol. Wreaths were laid, poppies and sprigs of rosemary were placed to commemorate the contribution and sacrifice of veterans and serving personnel across time. We honour, remember and thank those who have served.

After the service approximately 40 people enjoyed a cooked breakfast at the Elliston Community Hall. Thank you to everyone involved and who helped organise the service and breakfast.

The council has been successful in obtaining grant funding under the Department for Veterans Affairs Saluting Their Service Commemorative Grants Program to restore the Elliston Cenotaph.

The work will include cleaning and repainting the lettering and rendering the base.

The funding was approved by the Minister for Veterans' Affairs, Hon Andrew Gee MP.

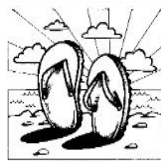
