





Beach Wrack

Sustained westerly gales and currents in July have added significantly to marine detritus (or wrack), washed up at Anxious Bay. Seagrass, a flowering plant, shed their leaves in late autumn and early winter. Accumulations are highly transient, as this material will rot down and be moved back into the coastal marine system to contribute to an ecological chain. Wrack tends to sink to the sea bed under calmer conditions, but can be re suspended with wave and current action.

Some 40 species of birds utilize the beach wrack for nesting, shelter and food. Wrack is alive with microscopic biota, including bacteria and detritivores. These mineralize nutrients and are a rich source for small crustacea (amphipods, ostracods), mites, diptera (fly larvae) and nematodes (worms). Second order consumers including spiders, beetles and bird scavengers like the ruddy turnstone prey on the macro fauna.

The migratory ruddy turnstone, a small and shy bird, and always observed in flocks, can be seen foraging on the exposed beaches at low tide and shelters in wrack at high tide. These are migratory species, breeding in the high Arctic, and a regular summer migrant from August to April. They may overwinter, some in breeding plumage.
