SUMMER FLEDGING TIME AND LEARNING LIFE SKILLS

Fledgling birds are learning to fly and catch their own resources/prey at this time of year. How do adults teach their offspring to be independent?

Last year around this time, we watched a persistent fledgling willy wagtail loudly begging for food on the ground, whilst a parent demonstrated rapid sideways tail movement, deft insect catching in the air and the rapid erratic movement on the ground. The fledgling didn't give up, repeatedly running to the parent for food. The parent did relent after some time, but not before teaching a survival behavior.

Fledglings are vulnerable to any new situation, even with parents nearby. Only yesterday, a fledgling New Holland Honeyeater wedged its head in bird netting and became very tangled. After being released using scissors to cut the netting, it sat on a perch not far away, and proceeded to preen its feathers. It showed no fear of being handled, however a learning experience.

How do fledgling birds learn? Statistics say that **37%** of birds leaving the nest and learning to fly make it through their first year of life. Mortality rate in the first year of Peregrine Falcons in their first year can be as high as **50%** due to starvation. They lacked the energy to engage, due to inexperience, ineptitude, lack of available prey or simply bad luck.

How long do baby birds stay in the nest?

Altricial species are born nearly featherless, and with their eyes closed, may leave the nest from 8- 12 days after hatching. These include the small song birds like the Welcome Swallow or the New Holland Honey eater (11-32 days). Parents spend considerable effort continuously feeding hungry chicks.

Young birds born with down feathers (precocial), may leave the nest to follow their parents within a few hours after hatching. As soon as they dry off, they are alert, active and able to get up and walk around. These include ducks, waterfowl and shorebirds.

Some large birds like owls, hawks and eagles develop more slowly and spend the first 3 months in the nest with their mothers. The time spent is in eating and gaining strength. The albatross chick is 7.5 months old, an average of 240 days before they fledge. There is a correlation between average of fledging, body size and life span (years).

What is a fledgling? Behaviours include:

Flight feathers present around the wings

Making bird calls

Is bright and responsive, spreading it's wings a lot and flapping

Hopping on the ground and can perch on a branch

The average age of small bird fledgling is 12-21 days. After approx. 3 weeks, parents stop feeding the fledgling, and may peck at them if they persist in begging for food. Fledglings can take up to 2 weeks to learn how to fly, and may be dependent on their parents for food for up to a year. While fledglings are learning to fly, it is critical that they stay with their parents so they can defend them from potential threats.

Learning to fly and fend for yourself can be a threatening undertaking in the natural world.

If you come across a young bird, and you are concerned for its welfare, your intervention can be misguided. Adult birds are often very close, shadowing their offspring, and providing the required support.

The **Eyre Peninsula Native Animal Rescue** is devoted to the rescue and rearing of injured and orphaned Australian Native Animals and Birds. Sadly, many birds fall victim to being struck by a motor vehicle and it is on the open road where many of the victims are found. Injured birds who suffer damage to their wings may never fly again and will need aviary accommodation.

Native animal carers are based in Pt Lincoln, and are able to assist with the rescue of birds on Eyre Peninsula.
