

#### Migratory shorebirds arriving from the northern hemisphere

The Elliston Branch of the SACWA present the summer edition of our local bird series.

Dry ephemeral salt lakes along the coastline both north and south of Elliston, are indicative of little to no spring rain heading into summer. The feral rock pigeons are flying low over the town, ready to access any available fresh water. Lake Newland Conservation Park, approximately 30km to the north of Elliston, features the most extensive wetland on the Eyre Peninsula. The natural saline lakes and freshwater springs extend some 20km in length, providing habitat for up to 120 species being recorded, with a significant number of migratory wader species and waterfowl. Dec.-Jan are the peak arrival months.

Migratory shorebirds coming to Australasia (including New Zealand), use the East Asian- Australasian flyway (EAAF), one of the largest of 8 flyways that have been defined in the world. From Siberia, an estimated 2 million birds cover some 12, 000km, and en-route rely on coastal wetlands, which are under pressure from human populations through China and Asia. Vast areas of natural coastal habitat have been lost over millennia, a trend that is escalating to an extreme degree.

There are 9 bilateral agreements involving 15 countries, providing a multinational framework for the conservation of migratory species.

How do they find their way? How important is roosting? How important is loafing?
