

Shorebird ID on our local beaches

The Elliston Branch of the SACWA present the 2024 March edition of our local bird series.

The Eyre Peninsula Landscape Board, in conjunction with birdlife Australia and NP&W Eyre Peninsula, recently held workshops on identifying shorebirds for novices and experienced people alike. Dr. Daniel Lees, from Birds Australia, accompanied by NP&W Eyre Peninsula ecologist Katrina Pobke, lead a workshop on the diversity of shorebirds, then fieldtrips to Second Ck, and the Tod River catchment near Tumby Bay. Great value seminar and field trip! Watch out for the next one.


What is a shore bird? These are a diverse group of water birds that share characteristics suited to feeding in shallow water and/ or wet mud or sand. They generally have long legs compared to their body size and have evolved a variety of beak lengths and shapes to access different prey below or on top of muddy or sandy substrates. Coastal shorebirds frequently visit intertidal flats, the part of the coast that is exposed at low tide to feed.

Comparing two species common to Elliston:

White faced heron	Red necked stint
Resident. Sometimes as adult pair. Sometimes as juvenile escaping bullying from parents. Often stands in water watching for movement. Eats fish, crustaceans, worms, aquatic insects & lar- vae. Also small reptiles, amphibians. frog spi- ders, beetles	migratory, breeds Siberia & Alaska some 12, 000 km one way. No two species have identical routes/ stopover locations or destinations. They use the East Asian Australiasian Flyway, starting in Russia and Alaska and extending southwards to SE Asia, Australia and New Zealand,
