

FIRE PERMITS

Burning during the fire danger season period should only be considered as a last resort.

Consider, do I have to burn now, or can this wait until a safer time during the year?

Fire Permits are mandatory for any fires during the Fire Danger Season. If you intend to burn or conduct broadacre burning, you must request a permit from an Authorised officer listed below:

Individuals have the convenience of completing their fire permit applications in the District Council of Elliston area online.

To complete the online application, click on the following link:

For timely processing, permit applications should be submitted at least 2 days prior to the planned burning date.

Permit applications once approved, require the activation of a permit. The applicant must call the Authorised Officer PRIOR (minimum 2 hours) to burn off commencing, to **Activate** the permit.


Once activated the permit can only be used once and if further burn offs are needed on different days, then a new permit will need to be applied for.

Please read <u>District Council of Elliston Broadacres Burning Permit Conditions</u> to assist in the practice of safe broad acre stubble burning, windrow burning & stubble dump burning.

PERMITS ARE NOT VALID ON A FIRE BAN DAY

Tenth Schedule Hot Work Permits are available only through the District Council of Elliston Fire Prevention Officers or Region 6 office.

Fire safety and Fire prevention information is available through the Council website or CFS SA.



Who's counting?

The Elliston Branch of the SACWA Inc present the 2024 April edition of our local bird series.

Birds Australia will be conducting its bi-annual coastal bird census soon, to ascertain population numbers of all species, and more importantly, the breeding success by number of fledglings and the number of breeding pairs particularly of threatened species.

Of particular interest this year is the **Fairy Tern** (which is a threatened species). Fairy Terns will only breed in isolated coastal lagoons in synchronized breeding in small flocks from Nov- March. Adults plunge dive into shallow water after small fish, which are fed whole to young.

Fairy tern numbers are decreasing drastically. They are smaller than Caspian, Crested and Little terns.

The Eyre Peninsula Landscape Board release a "Birding Guide for EP boaters and fishers", which is well worth obtaining. It contains excellent photographs for easy identification. Fairy terns are *very rare*, so skill up on its ID. To identify a bird from similar or other species, a comparison is useful: the common silver gull stands some 40cm, and the Fairy tern 23cm. Many coastal birds suffer threats from habitat loss, extreme weather, depletion of food, dogs, vehicles, birds of prey, rats, foxes and gulls.
