

There is also some interbreeding with Zosterops lateralis gouldi, (which extends from W.A.'s Shark Bay following the coast to Eucla and across to Streaky Bay)

The agility, resourcefulness, and repertoire of sounds from the petite silvereye makes this songbird a standout in the bird ecology of Elliston.

Measuring just 11-13cm in length, and weighing in at around 10g, this bird is easily recognized by a conspicuous ring of white feathers around the eye. These olive green and grey birds have been intensively studied for over two decades, in an attempt to discover their migratory movements.

Many gardeners will be well aware of their presence in early December, where groups descend for the summer fruit season. Being omnivorous, their diet includes insects (eg aphids, caterpillars & flies), nectar (from native trees and flowers), fruit (including grapes, cherries, apples, pears, figs, apricots and peaches) plus berries.

With a small but very pointed beak and a brush tipped tongue, they engage in lively chattering and chirping while foraging for food. Their aerial techniques showcase their agility, hovering in mid air, pouncing on prey, gleaning tree trunks, leaves and twigs, inspecting every nook and cranny, and engage in chasing- following their prey, darting through branches and leaves.

More than enough activity and vocals to attract the attention of the gardener.

Come the end of April, into autumn, when food resources are significantly depleted, some bird species populations undertake lengthy migration from colder regions to warmer areas eg: Tas. To Qld. Others are more sedentary within their range.

Where does our population go? Our genus & species range from Denial Bay across E.P. up as far north as Wilcherry and across to Wilmington, then across the Murray Valley, also following the coast to Mt Gambier, and down to Melbourne, Vic.
