





The welcome swallow, the fast flying acrobat.

The welcome swallow was **first described** by John Gould, pioneering naturalist on his two year exploration of Australia starting in 1838. His descriptions and detailed notes culminated in his "<u>Birds of Australia</u>", the first comprehensive work on Australian ornithology, containing 680 hand coloured plates and descriptions into seven volumes from 1840- 1848.

It is a species native to Australia, and has been recorded in New Guinea, New Caledonia, and surrounding islands. It was self-introduced to New Zealand in the middle of the 20th century. The name 'welcome swallow' comes from sailors who knew that the sight of a swallow meant that land was not far away. They are listed as common, and sedentary in S.A., and are more often found near coastal and wetland areas. They can live in all types of habitat except alpine areas and very dense forest.

Its flight characteristics are striking: they can be seen fluttering, swooping and gliding in search of a wide variety of insects in flight. Their flying style is circular in pattern with swift darting motions. They often fly wide opened mouthed, fast and close to the ground in large circles or figure of eight patterns. They show a habit of drinking water while flying over lakes or pond surfaces, which allows them to catch insects in the water as well.

They have short bristles at the sides of their mouths called rictal bristles, common to many nocturnal species."Rictal' comes from the word rictus, the gape or corner of the mouth. The rictal bristle function? Nobody knows for sure, but the consensus seems to be that these have a sensory function, letting the bird know its speed and orientation in the air. Bristles could also follow tiny vortices left in the air by flying insects.

These birds are pairing at the moment and breed close to human habitation. The nest is an open cup of mud and grass, attached to a suitable structure such as a vertical wall or building and is made by both sexes. Parking a car underneath a nest can be problematic!




