This month we're shining the spotlight on one of our talented local commission stockists, SeaShell Creations, created by Petrea and Tamsin Meyers.

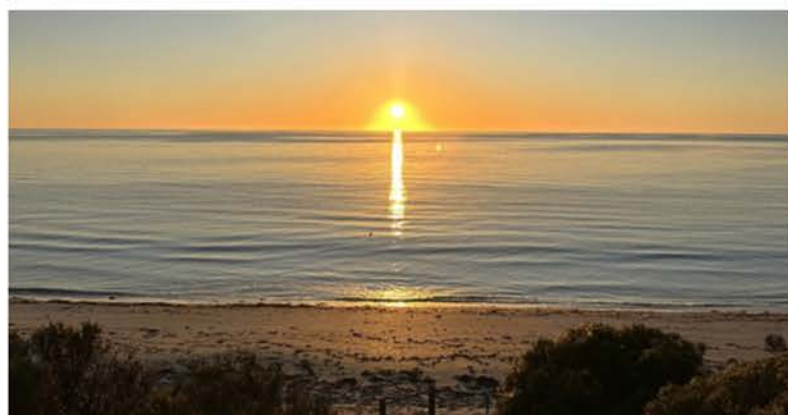

Warren brings a deeply personal perspective shaped by lived experience in farming, family life, financial stress, and the challenge of rebuilding after significant personal and professional loss. His story reflects the realities many in rural and regional communities face, and the importance of speaking openly about it. Through this session, Warren unpacks what it really means to navigate pressure over time, how stress can build quietly beneath the surface, and why recovery is rarely a straight line. He also explores practical ways individuals and communities can better recognise early signs of struggle, support one another, and build stronger foundations for wellbeing beyond simply "getting through it."

THE BEAUTIFUL BOGAN

Marc Ryan, The Beautiful Bogan, is a comedian and mental health advocate who's toured more than 70 shows across the Eyre Peninsula in the past five years. Blending raw honesty with big laughs, his recent shows What Would Gary Do? He has also featured on The ABC show "You Can't Ask That?" and The channel 10 show "Start Me Up" Marc's not scared of the tough topics he actually enjoys tackling them with humour and heart, making him one of Australia's most unique and powerful comedic voices.

- All dogs and cats over 3 months of age must be registered.
- Registrations must be completed by 31 August 2026.
- Dogs and cats born after July 2018 must be desexed before 6 months of age (or within 28 days of taking ownership), unless exempt.
- All dogs and cats must be microchipped before 3 months of age (or within 28 days of taking ownership).

PATIENT ASSISTANCE TRANSPORT SCHEME (PATS) – CHANGES FROM 1 JULY 2026

The Patient Assistance Transport Scheme (PATS) provides financial assistance to eligible regional South Australians who need to travel more than 100 km each way to access approved specialist medical services that are not available locally.

From 1 July 2026, the following subsidy increases apply:

Accommodation: Patient only: \$110 per night - Patient with an approved escort: \$154 per night - Interstate accommodation: \$154 per night

Fuel: 34.4 cents per kilometre for eligible travel.

These changes are designed to help reduce the financial burden on regional patients and their families when travelling for essential healthcare. For eligibility information or to make a claim, visit:
